#1

Provide vignettes that spark connections to the past



#2 Provide a looped walking path for pacing behavior

#3 Provide views while deterring elopement. If views out are of a natural setting, where there is not a lot of activity – (i.e. a place they want to go but can't), keeping an open view is fine.

#4 Provide safe space that allows autonomy

Include elements to encourage engagement in familiar activities



#6

Consider [using KBI FlexiPave](#) to reduce injury from falls

#7

Provide space for grandchildren to enjoy the outdoors during their visit



#8

Don't use surfaces that will create glare; stay with darker tones for pavement

Create a Pond-less Water Feature
